HMC HOLDS Grand Opening

On Saturday, May 9, 2015 a "picture perfect" sunny day, Dr. Alfred Rossi, CEO of Hopedale Medical Foundation, proudly cut the ribbon on the long anticipated \$8 million addition to the Hopedale Medical Complex. A crowd of approximately 350 guests, including dignitaries from the Central Illinois area, heard Dr. Rossi and guest speakers, Senators Darin LaHood, Bill Brady, the Village Mayor Ace Eilts, Dr. Casey Graybeal, and Mrs. Lorayne Rossi, marvel at the accomplishment of the Hopedale Medical Complex on its 60th anniversary. Msgr. Tim Nolan gave the invocation and C.O.O., Mark Rossi thanked everyone for their hard work and dedication that made the beautiful 35,000-square foot addition a reality. The new addition includes a modern three-suite emergency department, a six-suite outpatient surgery addition, six beautiful super-sized hospital rooms, a helipad, and a bright and spacious lobby with a second floor mezzanine surgical waiting area. Construction costs came in at just over \$8 million with an additional \$2 million spent on equipment, including an upgrade of a \$1 million angiography suite in the operating room. Groundbreaking was in October, 2012, but construction did not begin until October, 2013 which was the start of one of the fiercest winters in Illinois history. The harsh weather set back the construction schedule over two months, but it was largely made up in the summer of 2014. Core Construction built the building with the help of architectural firm SPACE from St. Louis. Over \$1 million was raised in the Capital Campaign of 2010, and approximately 60% of that money was utilized during the construction process. There are other items which are yet to be finished, including the chapel and a front entrance flagpole display with Veteran's Memorial park.


